

Bohuslav Luža



LIFE

- Bohuslav Luza was born on July 16, 1892 in Uherský Brod.

He was a member of the National Assembly and
From 1932 – to 1939 he was a mayor of Uherský
Brod

He was a very brave man, a respected person and a moral authority for people of Uherský Brod.

All money, which he saved from his mayor's salary he donated to the resistance movement and the children in the local monastery.

- Together with his brother Vojtěch Luža they had a big influence on the government's decision to build the Czech Arms Factory in Uherský Brod.



FAMILY

- In 1917 he married Berta Večeřová. He had 2 children : a son Miroslav and a daughter Milena.

STAY IN PRISON

- He helped to establish the resistance movement Defense of the Nation in Uherský Brod .
- Bohuslav Luža was arrested on September 1, 1939. Later he was prisoned in a concentration camp Dachau and from 1941 in Buchenwald where he died on May 7, 1945.



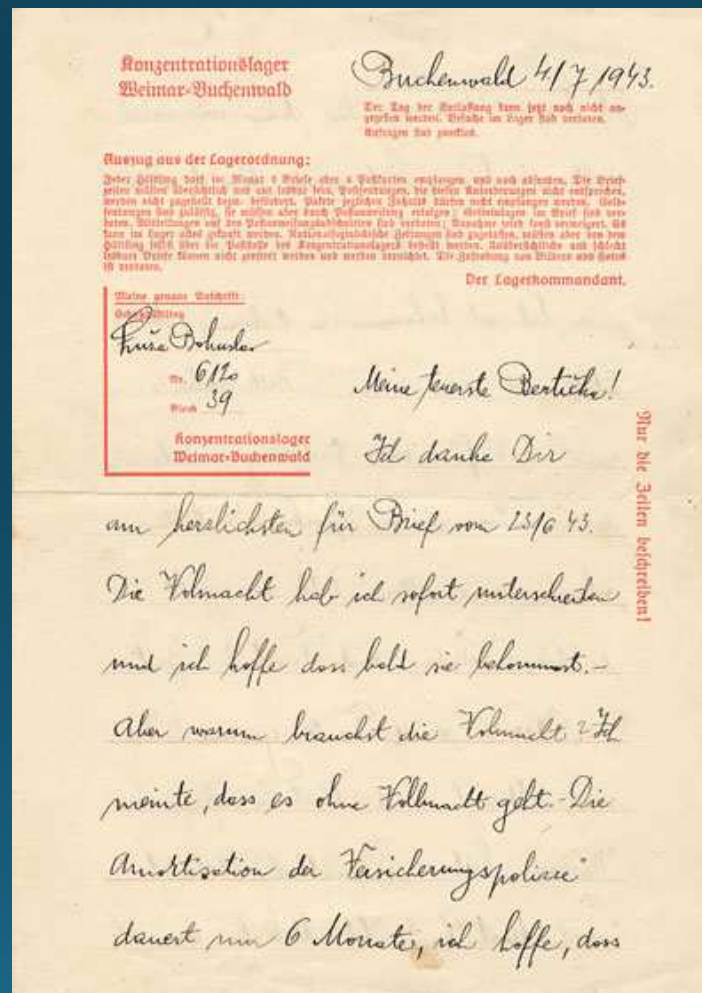
FUNERAL
